ICD-10-CM and ICD-10-PCS

Our application uses or stores ICD-9-CM codes. To help you prepare for the implementation of ICD-10-CM and PCS we are trying to facilitate your need to know. Please review the following questions and answers to help you with this process.

1. What version of your application will be ready to support ICD-10-CM and PCS?

Intelicode version 12.0.0.4 and later.

2. When will that version be ready for general release to your customers?

This version is currently available either by calling us or downloading from our website.

3. Please list systems requirements to load ICD-10 supported version.

System requirements will not change as a result of the update.

4. Please list all costs associated with the implementation of application upgrades needed to support ICD-10-CM or PCS? (Software, hardware, vendor implementation fees).

Updates are currently included in your subscription price.

5. Please provide any specifics regarding timeline for delivery, testing and implementation of ICD-10 supported application updates.

ICD-10's are currently available.

6. Explain how ICD-10-CM or ICD-10-PCS will be used by your software application.

Those using our software can choose either ICD-9 codes or ICD-10 codes as of 2013. Prior years (2012 and earlier) will only have the availability of ICD-9 codes.

6. Please provide a brief description on how your application will be able to accommodate both the ICD9 and ICD10 codes.

Both ICD-9 and ICD-10 codes are available with Version 12.0.0.4 and later. End user selects which code they would like to use.

7. Please specify if your application will be able to accommodate the ICD-10-CM, ICD-10-PCS and ICD-9-CM code sets in a dual use testing strategy

Patient visit date will determine ICD-9/ICD-10 use. Visit dates 2013 and after will be able to select either ICD-9 or ICD-10 codes if using Version 12.0.0.4 or later.

8. Please specify how the ICD-9-CM codes will be disabled once they are no longer needed by the customers.

Patient visit date will determine ICD-9/ICD-10 use. Applicable ICD-9/ICD-10 based on patient visit date are valid for 7 years.

9. Do other systems link to your application transmit ICD codes?

No other systems link to our application.

10. Please list all vendor-supported interfaces that will be affected by the ICD-10-CM and ICD-10-PCS code sets and how you will remediate.

There are no vendor-supported interfaces that will be affected.

11. Please provide detailed steps that company's must perform to implement ICD-10-CM and ICD-10-PCS.
